BAGGAGE GUIDELINES PER PERSON

Our baggage requirements are important for the safety and security of passengers and crew. **Baggage must be portable; each piece easily and quickly moved by crew members as needed.**

We ask for your cooperation regarding baggage transport. We will do our best to accommodate your baggage and ask for your assistance. We understand the special needs for the transport of camp equipment. Please follow these guidelines for size and weight.

GENERAL BAGGAGE GUIDELINES

Baggage Guidelines per Person

Two pieces of baggage

50 lbs. maximum each baggage

Baggage must be within the dimensions of 23"x23"x37"

One carry-on bag to be stowed under the seat

Campers and Hikers will be allowed one sleeping bag as an extra piece of luggage.

SPECIAL TRAVEL TIPS FOR CATALINA CAMPERS & HIKERS

- Plan to pack efficiently. Luggage accommodations aboard the vessels are limited.
- Please keep ice chest sizes to 60 quarts or smaller and 50 lbs. or less.
- Pack only what might be perishable/frozen in your ice chests.
- Empty out extra water or melted ice from the ice chest.
- Use duct tape opposed to bungee cords. *(Bungee cords tend to get snagged and can become dangerous.)*
- Bundle beach chairs together.
- Consider gear rentals from on Island suppliers.
- One tent allowed per person. Cannot exceed 48".
- One beach umbrella per person. Cannot exceed 37".
- No four-wheel carts or fixed wagons.
 - *Four wheel dollies or hand trucks that convert onto two wheels are permitted. Must be converted onto two wheels before going down the ramp and through the duration of the boat ride.*
- Straps and snaps on backpacks should be snapped together and fastened. Please no canteens, tennis shoes, loose items tied to exterior of backpacks.
- Collapsible wagons that are emptied and collapsed are allowed.
- Hiker backpacks that are 4 ft. in height maximum are allowed.
- Walking sticks 4 ft. in length or smaller acceptable.
- All non-baggage items travel at owner's risk.

Not Allowed by US Coast Guard: These typical camping items are **not allowed** aboard the vessels: camp stoves and lanterns *(except electric or when propane or butane canisters are removed)*, fuel canisters *(propane or butane, white gas)* can be purchased on the Island. Charcoal, cots, firewood, gasoline, kerosene, outboard motors, flammables.
